Employability Oriented Skill Courses



Employment opportunities increase if students possess special skills apart from academic degrees. Now a days employability skills have become an integral part of curriculum. Employers today desperately seek people with combination of skills which not only cover technical or hard skills but also include soft skills. These skills help our students to jump start their career and prepare them to face the competitive world. To encourage students and boost employment varied skill courses were initiated in the college.

A course on "Soft Skills and Personality Development" is being conducted in the college by Higher Education Department in collaboration with Central University of Jammu. With a batch size of 30 students (both boys and girls) the course is of 200-250 hrs. duration. The mode of teaching is blended and sessions are conducted both offline and online.

To acquaint the students with technology a computer course of 80 hours duration "Course on Computer Concepts" was conducted in the college by NIELIET. With a batch size of 30 students two batches were run simultaneously keeping in mind the demand of the course.

A youth employability programme was conducted for students by the Tata Consultancy Service in collaboration with District Employment and Counselling Centre, Jammu. The student intake of the said course was 50 and the time duration was 90-100 hours.
