With an objective to educate students to protect life, health and to ensure respect for every human being, the Red Ribbon Club in collaboration with IQAC of GDC R. S. Pura celebrated World Red Cross Day by organising a First Aid Activity to save lives under the patronage of Prof. (Dr.) Rajni Bhagat, Principal of the college and guidance of Prof Neelam Kumari, Convener RRC.
