To commemorate the day, Drug De-addiction Committee of GDC R.S.Pura organized an awareness campaign based on the theme,"The evidence is clear: invest in prevention,". More than 30 students of the college	

including faculty members were participated in the event with great zeal, enthusiasm and fervor. In this connection a pledge was taken by students followed by Poster Making Competition in order to aware the public about drug abuse. Thereafter a motivational Lecture was also deleivered by Prof Neelam Kumari with the aim to raise awareness about the importance of treating people who use drugs with respect and empathy, providing evidence-based, voluntary services for all, offering alternatives to punishment, prioritizing prevention and leading with compassion.
