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COURSES OFFERED BY GDC R.S. PURA AT UNDER GRADUATE LEVEL

The college offers admission to three years undergraduate programme in different streams, spread over six semesters under CBCS.

Courses offered by College at UG level comprises of:

- A. **Core Course (CC)**
(For Science & Art Students) From Semester I to Semester IV.
- B. **Ability Enhancement Courses (AECC)**
(For Science Students) From Semester I to Semester VI.
(For Arts Students) From Semester I to II and V to VI.
- C. **Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC)** From Semester III to Semester VI.
- D. **Generic Elective Course (For Arts Students only)** From Semester V to Semester VI.

- **Core Course**: comprises of three main subjects both in medical, non- medical and arts streams whereas in arts stream the third core subject needs to be opted by the student out of English/Hindi/Urdu/Dogri/Punjabi i.e. English / MIL.
- Core course needs to be compulsorily studied both by a science and arts student as a basic requirement. There shall be a total of 12 core papers, with three papers from each core subject to be studied in first - fourth semesters (I-IV).

B. Ability Enhancement Courses

• Ability Enhancement Compulsory Course (AECC)

Ability Enhancement compulsory Courses include Communication English/MIL and EVS. EVS is compulsory both for science and arts students in semester I and semester II. However, One subject out of Communication English/MIL have to be studied by the science student in semester I to Semester VI and for arts students, one subject out of Communication English/MIL have to be studied in semester I to Semester II and in semester V to Semester VI. Each Ability Enhancement Compulsory Course shall be of two credits.

C. Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC)

- One paper in each semester starting from semester III to semester VI of skill enhancement course shall be opted by the student BA/B.Sc. as per their desire out of variety of choices displayed by the college. Each SEC Course is of four credits.

D. Elective Courses: Discipline Specific Elective Course (DSE)

- Both Science and Arts students have to study DSE course in semesters V and VI with three papers in each semester. These elective courses are based - as per the core courses opted by the students in semester-I.
- Each DSE Course shall be of six credits.
- SEC of four credits will continue in semester V and semester VI as opted by the student in semester III and IV.

E. Elective: Generic (GE)

- Arts students will opt Elective Generic (GE) course of six credits both in semester V and Semester VI and that must be other than core subjects opted in semesters III and IV.

The courses shall be evaluated through a grading system in place of conventional marking system. Each semester course shall be evaluated on the basis of SGPA (Semester Grade Point Average) and the cumulative SGPA of all the six semesters will become the CGPA of a student for purpose of award of degree.

Instructions

- ❖ Students seeking admission in Semester I are required to apply in three different possible combinations according to their respective streams.
- ❖ Admission will be granted purely on student merit and preferences, allotted enrollment capacity as per the directions of HED, and available infrastructure.
- ❖ Validity of the list will be strictly adhered as per the University notification notified by the University of Jammu.
- ❖ The admission of student is liable to be cancelled in the event of wrong information furnished by him/her at any stage of admission.

Fee receipt is an important admission document. SC/ST/OBC students are advised to keep it for future benefits, if any, and the same shall not be issued from this office again.

ARTS STREAM

Students may fill the form as per the CBCS scheme. Arts students will have to study core subjects opted by them in semester I and semester II and one Skill Enhancement Course as per their choice out of possible courses as per existing guidelines of HED.No AECC for students of arts in this semester. Each core subject is of six credits and Skill Enhance Course is of four credits.

SCIENCE STREAM

Students may fill the form as per the CBCS scheme. Students will continue three core subjects as opted by them in semester I& II and one AECC (English/Hindi/MIL-3) and one Skill enhancement course as per their choice out of possible courses as per existing guidelines of HED.Each core subject is of six credits, Skill Enhance Course is of four credits and AECC of two credits.

SUBJECT COMBINATION FOR B.A/B.Sc. SEMESTER-V &VI (CBCS)

ARTS STREAM

Students may fill the form as per the CBCS scheme. SEC of four credits will continue in fifth semester. Students have to opt any two subjects as Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) courses from subjects of Core courses opted in semesters III & IV. Each DSE course shall be of six credits. Besides this, Generic elective course of six credits [i.e. a course unrelated to core courses opted in the earlier semester(s)] will be introduced in this semester as a compulsory subject.

SCIENCE STREAM

Students may fill the form as per the CBCS scheme. One AECC Course out of English/MIL of two credits and one SEC of four credits will continue in Vth&VIth semesters. Core courses shall be replaced by Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) courses. Each DSE course shall be of six credits. No Generic Elective Course for science students in semester V and Semester VI.

PAYMENT OF ADMISSION FEE

Each student seeking admission in BA/B.Sc Course, under CBCS shall be required to submit online the prescribed application form along with requisite fee(Online/Offline through generated Bank e-challan) :

- For the first and second semester courses at the time of seeking admission to first semester.
- For the third and fourth semester courses at the time of seeking admission to third semester.
- For the fifth and sixth semester courses at the time of seeking admission to fifth semester.

Provided that the student continues his/her studies without interruption from first semester to second semester, from third semester to fourth semester and from fifth to sixth semester. If there is a gap of one or more semesters, He/She will have to fill up the prescribed application form and pay the fee at the time of seeking admission.

ELIGIBILITY/PROMOTION CRITERIA UNDER CBCS

Under the semester system scheme introduced by Jammu University for three years B.A/B.Sc. programme, there will be six semesters with two semesters in each year & the admission process will be only at I, III & V Semester with the following pre requisite conditions

1. The minimum marks required to pass a student in a semester end examination shall be 36% of total marks in each internal assessment, theory & practical (wherever applicable) examination.
2. **A student will be eligible for promotion from semester II to III, from semester IV to V, if he/she has secured required credits (as notified by the university) in semester I & III and pass in 75% subjects of Internal assessment of semester II/IV besides appearing in one of the external papers of semester II/IV as the case may be/ as per the latest notification of university of Jammu.**

SUPPLEMENTARY EXAMINATION

There shall be supplementary examination only for the semester V and Semester VI. No such supplementary examination for semester I to semester IV.

INTERNAL ASSESSMENT:

Under CBCS pattern , 20% of marks are allotted to each theory paper & 50% of marks are allotted to each practical paper for Internal Assessment and there shall be only one theory test both of science and arts students for internal assessment award after the completion of 50% of syllabus (in 45 days).

CONDONATION OF LECTURES

Principal of the college is vested with the powers of condonation upto six percent of lectures delivered or practicals conducted in each course separately.

PASSING CRITERION

The minimum Grade(Marks)/Grade point required to pass each paper in a semester examination under CBCS shall be Grade D (Marks 36% to <40%) / Grade point 4 in each theory paper/practical/project(where ever applicable) in external examination and internal assessment separately.
