





A total of 30 NSS volunteers of the college participated in this activity.

Proceeding of the function was initiated by Dr. Namita Singh, NSS Programme Officer. The event initiated by Pledge taking ceremony to mark the occasion. Dr. Namita Singh, NSS Programme Officer presented a detailed report on the achievements of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel, also known as the "Iron Man" of India. In her report, she informed the NSS volunteers that Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel was India's first home minister and also the first deputy prime minister and died at the age of 75. Principal, Prof. Kalpana Kesar was the chief guest on the occasion. In her address to NSS volunteers, she educated the volunteers about the great accomplishments of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel and informed the students that as a mark of respect, Prime Minister Narendra Modi today inaugurated Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel's statue, known as the Statue of Unity, in the Narmada district of Gujarat. She also informed the volunteers that The Sardar Patel statue is twice as tall as the Statue of Liberty and has been built at a cost of Rs. 2,989 crore. Dr. Ranjodh Singh, HoD History in his lecture highlighted the contributions of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel in uniting India as a "One Nation" which was earlier divided into number of big and small princely states along with British India. He also highlighted the stature of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel in the history of Indian politics. Ms. Muskaan Choudhary and Mr. Sahil bHagat of Semester I also spoke on the occasion and highlighted the work done by Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel in promoting Political Integration of India.
