



A total of 30 NSS volunteers of the college participated in this activity.

Proceeding of the function was initiated by Dr. Namita Singh, NSS Programme Officer. The event initiated by Pledge taking ceremony to mark the occasion. Dr. Namita Singh, NSS Programme Officer presented a detailed report on the achievements of Sardar Vallabhabhai Patel, also known as the "Iron Man" of India. In her report, she informed the NSS volunteers that Sardar Vallabhabhai Patel was India's first home minister and also the first deputy prime minister and died at the age of 75. 
